DECLARATION AS TO THE STATUS OF THE APPLICANT

Transport for London (TfL) is a statutory body created by the Greater London Authority Act 1999 and is the body responsible for London's transport system.

Its role is to implement the Mayor's Transport Strategy and manage transport services across London, for which the Mayor of London has ultimate responsibility.

It is directed by a Board whose members are chosen for their understanding of transport matters and appointed by the Mayor of London, who chairs it. TfL's Commissioner and chief officers are accountable for the daily running of the organisation and the work of its 25,000 employees.
