Subject: Network Rail Anglia Level Crossing Reductions TWA Order

I am writing to object in a small way to the proposed Network Rail (Cambridgeshire Level Crossing Reduction) Order.

My objection is a very small one, namely that in Schedule 15 (Prohibition of vehicular traffic etc), the word "motor" should be omitted wherever it occurs, so as to allow Network Rail to prohibit the use of all vehicles over the specified widths and height. My reason for making this objection is simply that the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 prescribe signs for limiting the width and height of all vehicles (diagrams 629A and 629.2A), but none for limiting the width and height of motor vehicles only. This change would thus simplify the signage required to indicate the effect of the order.
