This email is a representation from Harston Parish Council on the above topic.

Harston Parish Council supports this level crossing closure on the grounds of safety.

However, the public footpath, which traverses this level crossing, is used by considerable numbers of walkers and is, hence, seen locally as an important community asset.

There are plans to replace this asset with a new foot route that includes making use of an existing bridge. Harston Parish Council requests that this new route is constructed and is fully operative before this level crossing is closed. We have no wish to loose this community asset.
