

Dear Mrs Vincent and Ms O'Neil,

C31 Littleport Station

Cambridgeshire County Council had raised a holding objection to this proposal based on the fact that the proposals for Littleport were not supported by any evidence relating to the potential transport impacts of the changes.

A technical note was subsequently submitted, followed by additional iterations, most significantly to ensure that background growth of Littleport was included. The conclusions within the technical note are that the proposals would not constitute a 'severe' impact on the local highway network, and this is accepted.

The County Council does have concerns about the surrounding crossing/pedestrian access and street lighting in the underpass, and believes that these require improvement. However, the County Council reluctantly accepts NR's view that these issues are outside the reasonable scope of this specific application and therefore withdraws its holding objection to this proposal.

CCC will pursue the improvement works through other opportunities.

I therefore advise that the County Council has withdrawn its holding objection to this proposal.
