

Suggested amendment to article 14:

Closure of level crossings

- 14.—(1) Subject to paragraphs (3), and ~~((4) and (5))~~, the level crossings listed in column (2) of Part 2 of Schedule 2 (Closure of level crossings) are stopped-up and discontinued.
- (2) Upon the stopping up and discontinuance of the level crossings referred to in paragraph (1)—
- (a) any rights of way over those crossings are extinguished; and
 - (b) any public rights of way specified in column (3) of Part 2 of Schedule 2 are extinguished to the extent specified, by reference to the numbers and letters shown on the deposited plans.
- (3) Any person who suffers loss by the suspension or extinguishment of any private right of way under this article is entitled to compensation to be determined, in case of dispute, under Part 1 of the 1961 Act.
- (4) This article does not apply so as to extinguish the rights of statutory undertakers to maintain their apparatus.
- (5) Paragraphs (1) and (2) are not to have effect until, in respect of :
- (a) High Elm crossing and
 - (b) Bures crossing
- listed in that Part of that Schedule, such alterations to existing highway authorised by this Order as agreed with the highway authority has been constructed and completed within Order limits to the reasonable satisfaction of the highway authority in accordance with article 15 (creation and maintenance of new highway) and is open for use.
