Having lived in Newport or Cardiff for the majority of my 40 years I have had to endure the stress and inconvenience caused by traffic delays and congestion caused by the M4 motorway between junction 26 (Coldra, Brynglas Tunnels) to Junction 28.

I am therefore delighted the a solution has been proposed by the Welsh Government to construct a new motorway to the south of Newport. I fully support the published scheme that I have seen at the Public Exhibitions and believe that it will provide the best solution to the chronic transport problems that being endured in South Wales.

Furthermore I fully support the proposed improvements to Junction 28 of the M4 and would plead that these are undertaken as soon as possible. Traffic congestion backs up from this Junction to beyond my home in Rogerstone during rush hour. Travel time from my home in Rogerstone to the M4 takes circa 30 minutes during this period, a journey that takes 3 minutes during normal periods.
