Further to this notice being served on me I wish to make the following objection.

The order is for a temporary acquisition of land approximately 90 metres long and 5 metres wide. The purpose of the order is to make the road wider to allow traffic to continue along the A4421 whilst lorries are waiting to turn.

On this small piece of land there are 3 mature oak trees, which obviously cannot be felled or have roots disturbed for such a small reason.

The order states that the area of land 339 square metres of agricultural land, hedgerow and Fringford footpath 9 it does not mention the trees. Is this a mistake by your surveyors ?

Your letter states that the order is subject to an environmental impact assessment, please send me a copy of this plan or if it has not been carried out inform me when it will happen so that I can attend.
